Local Government Reform Public Consultation in Port-of-Spain

Kent House, Maraval. March 14th, 2016: The Ministry of Rural Development and Local Government invites you to attend the series of public consultations on Local Government Reform.

The consultation for the region of Port-of-Spain takes place on **Wednesday March 16th, 2016 at the Port-of-Spain City Hall Auditorium at 6pm**. This is the seventh in a series of fourteen consultations (one for each Municipal Corporation) to be held over the coming months.

The Consultation is designed to invite input from local stakeholders and the wider public as an approach to increase productivity, improve quality of governance and deliver services efficiently.

Minister of Rural Development and Local Government, Senator the Honourable Franklin Khan, will present the local government structure and the proposed new role of the Municipal Corporations. The new function involves additional responsibilities for the corporations as they move towards greater autonomy.

Stakeholders and the public will be able to gain greater understanding of the nine key areas to be addressed in the transition namely: funding, executive authority, new responsibilities, inclusion of local contractors and infrastructural development, effective municipal policing, development control, disaster management, regional development plans and involvement of civil society.
